

***EXPLORING COLOR: (ages 7-12) NEW HOME-SCHOOL SPECIAL! Session A only***

Students will review and expand their understanding of the color wheel and embark on informed color mixing. You will explore “drawing” with brushes and massing in color, creating vibrant color and spontaneity to you art. Materials provided. **b. i.**

**Supplies-**

- Acrylic Paint- 1 small tube of each of the following (2 reds, 2 blues, 2 yellows, black and white): Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue, Cadmium Lemon, Cadmium Red Medium or Light, Cerulean Blue, Cadmium Yellow Light or Medium, Mixing White and Ivory Black
- Watercolor Paper, Cold Press, #140 lb, at least 9x12
- Graphite Pencils
- Ruler
- 3-brushes (recommend filberts sizes 4,6, 8),
- Pallet Paper (to mix paints on) and palette knife
- Smock or apron.
- Rags or paper towels
- Jars for cleaning
- Pictures to work from, if you like

Learn how to layer your color to make your drawings more vibrant. You will use colored pencils or pastels to create textural effects and a finished look. Materials provided. **b.i.**

**Supplies-**

- Colored Pencils, a set of at least 8..
- Graphite Pencils: HB, and 2B
- Pencil Sharpener
- 2 small Needed Erasers
- Drawing Paper at least 8x10, at least 70 lb.
- Smock or apron.
- Pictures to work on, if you like
