## **Board Notes**

Membership dollars are up by almost 24%. Gallery sales are up 128% and gift shop sales are up 54%. Classes are solid. All good news.



The weather stripping on the front door will be replaced. This summer could be a challenge because all the sidewalks and the street are being re-done. We are guaranteed to have access to the building through the project and there will also be parking on one side of the street. The work begins on the East end of Front Street so it won't reach us for a while.

Work is beginning on a project to analyze the needs for an improved system to handle all our management processes including the website, our computer system and our accounting system. A software consulting firm will be providing information on four sources for possible systems to meet our needs.

There is some concern about a need for more space if the bank building currently used as an annex is purchased. A committee will be created to look into contingency plans.

We are close to reaching \$20,000 in Membership fees. We have attracted some new members through social media and an on-line site called Meet Up which publicizes events

The review of the By-Laws is complete and they were approved.

Plans are in the works for several possible workshops. More information to come.
