- OPTIONAL: One roll of SARAL blue transfer paper
- OPTIONAL: assortment of color fine pt color pens (Sharpie, Tombow, etc.)
- OPTIONAL: assortment of bold pt color pens (Sharpie, Prismacolor, etc.)

WordPortrait List-Builder Prompts: (work on in class)

- What nouns, verbs and adjectives describe you/your person best?
- What makes you/your person different, better or stands out a little bit more than all of the other people you know?
- What was the one event that brought the two of you together?
- What personality traits do you admire most about this person?
- Birthdates, anniversaries, baptisms, communions, etc.
- Special dates and favorite holidays that you/your person holds sacred
- Special moments (big and small) and artifacts that hold special meaning
- What are some of the first dates, first concerts, first trips, first cars?
- Favorite places to visit, travel to, hangout at, get together with friends
- Where have you/your person lived or spent time (i.e. military, work, volunteering)?
- All the names of siblings, family members, parents, grandparents (nicknames), nieces/nephews, cousins, aunts/uncles, etc.
- All of the pets you/your person has ever owned
- What catch phrases, mantras, made up quotes or nicknames do you share?
- Favorite quotes from movies, tv shows, commercials, or fictional characters
- Favorite hobbies, guilty pleasures, activities, rituals, books, etc.
- Favorite passages from the Bible? Quotes from books?
- What TV shows do you/your person have in common?
- Favorite memories, people you never want to forget, favorite good times
- Favorite foods, snacks, drinks, treats you/your person have in common
- Where are the places you/your person have worked together or have in common?

- What schools, colleges, universities have you/your person attended?
- Clubs, organizations, or sports teams you/your person have in common?
- What are some of their achievements, awards, or merits in their life?
- Favorite color, pattern, or texture?
- Favorite animal that is not their pet (some people like turtles, dolphins, tigers, monkeys for example for different reasons).
